Just an update on the Postcaravan. The trip is just about completed and the package should be ready in a couple weeks. Right now we will be traveling 5130 miles from Portland to Alaska and back to Dawson Creek, B.C. We are planning to have everyone with us from Dawson Creek to Alaska and back to Dawson Creek, since some will not be going to Portland at all. The above mileage will calculate out to about 125 miles a day since we will be gone those 5130 miles 40 days.

Most campground agreement have been made and a few have to be worked out. They are all private, but the type of service and prices varies depending on the location. Right now it looks like 27 stops at 23 campgrounds (4 twice).
